February: A Month of Prayer and Preparation – Week 2



Monday, Feb. 8

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 119:9-16** and **Hebrews 4:12-13**

This week, we will all be praying for a revival of study – a revival of hearts that are moved to know God and seek His will. Psalm 119:10 says “I seek you with all of my heart,” and vs. 16 says, “I delight in your decrees; I will not neglect your word.” God’s Word wants to work on our hearts. Take some time and pray that God will give you a heart that delights in Him, His love, and His Word.

Tuesday, Feb. 9

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 119:33-40** and **1 Thessalonians 2:13**

God’s promise of revival is to those who will “turn [their] eyes away from worthless things.” Paul commends the Thessalonians because they accepted his message, not as the word of men, but as the Word of God. Pray today that you, your family, and our church will treasure the Word of God and take it seriously, so that it will grow and change us.

Wednesday, Feb. 10

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 119:41-48** and **2 Corinthians 3:17-18**

This world tells us that freedom comes from individualism, but Scripture teaches us that as we turn toward the One who created us and truly loves us, we find true freedom. Today, pray that God will show you any places in your life that you have not fully surrendered to Him and commit to searching out *His* will for your life. Pray this prayer for our church family as well, so that we will all put our hope and our lives in His hands.

Thursday, Feb. 11

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 119:89-96** and **Matthew 7:24-29**

In today’s world, it’s easy to feel that nothing is sure or solid. But God’s Word is unchanging, sure, and trustworthy. We will only be secure as we trust and obey the One who always knows and does what is best for us. Today, pray for yourself, your family, and our church family that we would all rest our lives on the Rock that is Christ.

Friday, Feb. 12

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 119:129-136** and **2 Timothy 3:14-17**

Many voices compete for attention in this world, but truth is found only in God. Pray today that God will remind you of and draw you to His truth. Pray this for our church family as well.

Saturday, Feb. 13

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 119:169-176** and **Colossians 3:15-17**

Today, pray that God will increase your joy. God wants us all to know and share the joy of knowing Him through His Word and His work in us. He can do it!
