February: A Month of Prayer and Preparation – Week 3



Monday, Feb. 15

Scripture Readings: **Deuteronomy 30:19-20** and **1 John 3:1-3**

This week, we are praying for a revival of love – a revival of hearts that are moved to truly love God and demonstrate His love to others. Deuteronomy reminds us that “the Lord is your life.” John tells us that we are indeed, children of God because of His love. Pray today that God will increase your love for Him.

Tuesday, Feb. 16

Scripture Readings: **Hosea 10:12**, **Romans 12:2**, and **Hebrews 13:1-8**

God’s promise of revival is to those who are willing to turn from the patterns of the world. Loving, committed marriages bring honor and glory to God, especially in a culture where half the marriages fail. Pray today for the will to work to make your marriage a God-honoring one. If you’re not married, pray for those who are struggling in their marriages, that they will look to the One who truly loves them and submit their marriages to Him.

Wednesday, Feb. 17

Scripture Readings: **Deuteronomy 6:4-8** and **Matthew 18:2-6**

Children are one of our greatest gifts from God. Pray today that God will allow you to see your children, whatever their ages, with the loving eyes of Christ. Pray that God will increase your love for them and your wisdom in dealing with them. Pray for the children in our church, that we can commit to helping them know, love, and honor our Lord.

Thursday, Feb. 18

Scripture Readings: **Jeremiah 32:38-41**, **John 13:34-35** and **1 John 4:7-11**

Jesus said that the world would know us by our love for one another. John tells us to love each other as God loved us. Jeremiah shows how God has loved His people in concrete ways. Can you encourage your brethren to love God with singleness of heart and action? Can you “never stop doing good to them” and “rejoice in doing them good?” Pray. . . .

Friday, Feb. 19

Scripture Readings: **2 Chronicles 7:14** and **Romans 1:14-17**

We want to reach the world. This begins by humbling ourselves before God and asking Him to help us love the lost and reach out to them. Pray that God will give you and our church family a real love for the lost, a love that leads us to share *Him* with others.

Saturday, Feb. 20

Scripture Readings: **Isaiah 58:6-11** and **1 Corinthians 13:1-8a**

Pray today that God will give you a heart to **act** on His love for you and your love for others. Talk is great, but action is better! Pray that He will motivate and move all of us for Him and for His glory.
