February: A Month of Prayer and Preparation – Week 4



Monday, Feb. 22

Scripture Readings: **Exodus 24:3-7** and **1 Corinthians 1:8-9**

This week, we are praying for a revival of fellowship. Fellowship exists because God called us to be in fellowship with Him. He called the Israelites to offer fellowship [peace] offerings, which celebrated the fact that God was in relationship with His people. Paul tells us that God has called us into relationship with Jesus. Thank God today that you are in fellowship with Him. Pray that He will increase your closeness and commitment to Him. Pray this for our church family as well.

Tuesday, Feb. 23

Scripture Readings: **Psalms 133 (all)** and **1 Corinthians 12:12-27**

Our culture glorifies those who can “pull themselves up by their own bootstraps,” but God calls us into relationship with each other. He wants us to see our need for fellowship and to commit ourselves to pursuing God-honoring relationships within our church family. Only then will we become the church God calls us to be. Pray about this for all of us.

Wednesday, Feb. 24

Scripture Readings: **John 15:9-17** and **Romans 12:3-8**

Jesus told His disciples how to remain in His love: obey His commands, love, and serve each other. Paul tells us that we should exercise our faith by using our gifts in service to Christ and His body. Pray today that God will help you “spend yourself” on behalf of others, and especially, on behalf of Christ’s body, the church.

Thursday, Feb. 25

Scripture Readings: **Romans 12:9-11** and **Philippians 2:1-4**

Many see “religion” as a stale practice of stale beliefs, but we know that true life in Christ is one of great zeal and fervor for our Lord and His people, a life of total commitment to His way. Pray that God will give you His zeal. Pray this for our church family, too.

Friday, Feb. 26

Scripture Readings: **Ecclesiastes 4:9-12** and **Romans 12:12-13**

Solomon said that God knows we function better together. Part of fellowship is rejoicing together; part is persevering in trial together. Pray today that you can rejoice, hope, share, sympathize, and serve with God’s family at O’Fallon. That’s true fellowship!

Saturday, Feb. 27

Scripture Readings: **Romans 12:14-21** and **1 Peter 1:17-23**

Romans 12:14-21 are often applied to problems with non-Christians, but we all know that sometimes, we get “crosswise” with our brothers and sisters. Today, pray that we will **all** be committed to working things out, to loving each other “deeply from the heart.”
