February: A Month of Prayer and Preparation – Week 1



Monday, Feb. 1

Scripture Reading: **Psalm 51:7-12**

Which of the things David prayed for do you need? Forgiveness and a fresh start, joy and gladness, a pure and clean heart, renewed perseverance, a sense of God's presence, a renewed desire to do God's will? Pray for these in your own life and in the lives of others in our church family who share these needs.

Tuesday, Feb. 2

Scripture Readings: **Isaiah 57:14-15 and James 4:6-10**

God's promise of revival is to those with a humble and contrite heart. Consider what this might mean for you, and pray that we all might humble ourselves before God, that He might lift us up.

Wednesday, Feb. 3

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 86:11-13 and Mark 12:28-33**

What does it mean to have an undivided heart toward God? Can we be tempted to hold priorities that divert us from loving God with all our hearts? Today, pray that God will show you where you need to turn your heart toward Him more fully. Then take a moment to listen to what the Holy Spirit brings to your mind. Pray this prayer for our church family as well, so that we will love and serve God with *all* our hearts.

Thursday, Feb. 4

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 90:12-17 and Philippians 4:4-7**

It is so hard to be satisfied, joyful, and hopeful in this stressed-out world. Moses prayed that he and his people would be satisfied by God's unfailing love, so that they might sing and be glad all their days. Paul tells the Philippians that they can choose to rejoice in the Lord. Today, pray for yourself, your family, and our church family that we would all embrace the hope, joy, peace, and comfort available to us in Christ.

Friday, Feb. 5

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 139 (all) and John 14:15-21**

We need never feel alone if we know the Lord, but somehow, we still do. Pray today that God will remind you of His constant care and loving presence in your life and the lives of our church family and inspire you to lean upon Him today and every day.

Saturday, Feb. 6

Scripture Readings: **Psalm 103:1-13 and 2 Corinthians 4:16-18**

It's easy to become discouraged, but our God never changes, never deserts us, never stops loving us. In fact, He renews and revives us, because He is a God of grace and mercy. Pray today that we will all recognize and depend upon the one who loves us so!
